

MINUTES MONROE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION JANUARY 14, 2010

The Monroe County Board of Education met in regular session Thursday, January 14, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. in the Boardroom at the Director of Schools' Office. Eight Board Members present: Dr. Larry Stein, Chairman, Mrs. Lisa McLemore, Mrs. Sonya Lynn, Mr. Jerry Snyder, Mr. Danny Isbill, Mrs. Janet Martin, Mr. Dean Williams, and Mr. DeWitt Upton. Mr. Ron Eydt was absent.

Item No. 1: The Chairman introduced the three student representatives for the second semester as follows: Sweetwater High School (1st District) – Shivani Patel; Sequoyah High School (2nd District) – Nate Chapman; Tellico Plains High School (3rd District) – Brittany Murphy.

Item No. 2: The Chairman made a motion, seconded by Mr. Dean Williams to include three additional items under new business on the January 14, 2010 regular meeting agenda (items 9, 10 & 11 of the minutes). Motion passed. Mr. Dean Williams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Danny Isbill to add a discussion between items 1-14-6 and 1-14-7. Motion passed. Item No. 13: Next was a discussion of safety concerns at Tellico Plains Jr. High School. The Board asked the Director to get an estimate on the cost of enclosing the breezeway at Tellico Plains Jr. High School and Madisonville Middle School.

Item No. 15: The Director reported to the Board on the following: Attendance Awards were presented to Rural Vale Elementary School and Sweetwater High School; Monroe Academy has graduated twelve students since the beginning of 2009-10 school year; January 24-30, 2010 is "School Board Appreciation Week"; schools are preparing for spring testing; mid-term principal evaluations are complete.
